Originally a British military initiative, Jurassic Shark expeditions are now open to all experienced divers who want to play an active role in shark research and conservation. Previous expeditions have tagged a total of 62 sharks across the Eastern Pacific. They have won the Duke of Edinburgh's Prize for the British Sub-Aqua Club twice and been runner-up twice. This expedition will take place on our new 134' research vessel, M/Y SharkWater and will operate on a not-for-profit basis. There are 15 places available.
